- Please bring your Photocard Driving Licence as you will be unable to register and attend the course without it.
- Please allow plenty of time for your journey as roads can get congested at peak times.
- Courses start promptly at published times and late arrivals will not be admitted.

Car Parking: Yapton Lane can be accessed from A27 traffic travelling either east or west. Access is from the Yapton Road (B2132) along a short drive to free car parking. There is a main car park adjacent to the hotel with additional car parking areas available if required.

Upon arrival: Enter the hotel via the main pedestrian entrance and make your way to the main reception. Staff will direct you to the waiting area where refreshments will be served. Your course trainer will then meet you at this point and will accompany you to the event room.

Registration: It is important that you arrive in time for registration: late arrivals will be refused admittance onto the course. The course fee will not be reimbursed and you will be deemed not to have completed the course.

Identification: During registration at the venue you are required to produce your Photocard Driving Licence. Please refer to our Terms & Conditions or for further information please contact 0330 222 8999.

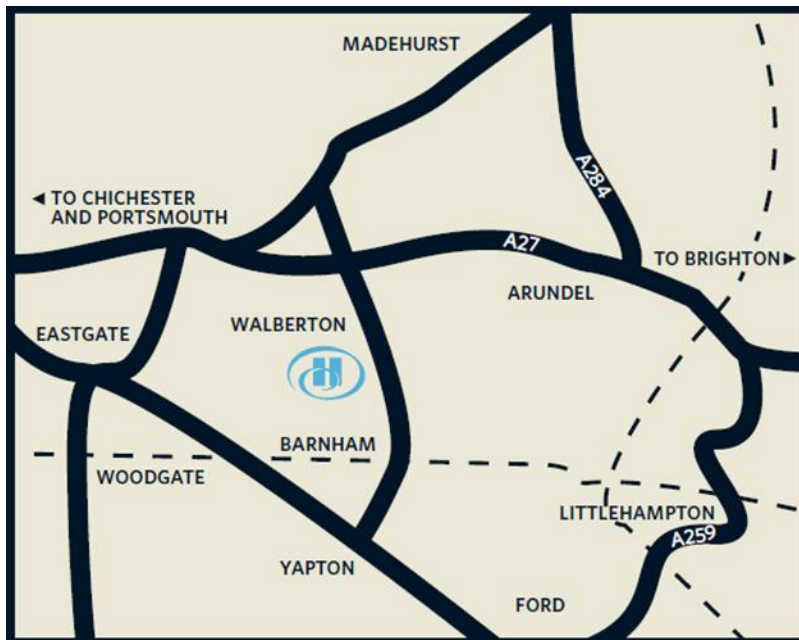
Suggestions by Road: From the North, East or West: Hilton Avisford Park is close to the A27 that runs between Chichester and Worthing. From the North, the A29 comes down and joins the A27 at Fontwell approximately $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile to the west.

Travelling south from the A27, the hotel estate has a brick perimeter wall. After approximately 250 metres along, the wall reduces in height on the approach to a right hand bend. Immediately after the right hand bend the hotel entrance is on the right with cream coloured pillars on either side. A large hotel sign is on the left hand side of the entrance.

From the South: Approaching from Walberton, the hotel entrance is about 850 metres north of the mini-roundabout junction with The Street in Walberton. Getting closer, a narrow lane, Hedgers Hill forks off to the right about 250 metres prior to the hotel entrance on the left.

Suggestion by Rail: The closest stations to the venue are Barnham & Ford. Barnham Station is approximately 3 miles from the venue; there is a local taxi firm that based at the station. Ford Station is approximately 3.5 miles from the venue, however there is **no** taxi operating out of this station. www.nationalrail.co.uk or www.southernrailway.com or 08457 484950
